- Use terminology appropriate to task (Call items by their correct names, e.g., mouse, hard drive, keyboard, etc.)

Students should know the names of the major parts of the computer:

- CD-ROM
- CPU
- desktop
- icons
- keyboard
- menu/taskbars
- monitor
- mouse
- printer
- wallpaper
- window

Students should be aware of the difference between an application (AppleWorks, Kid Pix, Microsoft Word etc.) and a file (work created by the student).
