

SB 2050 – NUMBER-OF-CYBERBULLYING-INCIDENTS (E17XX)

■ Data Element Reporting Requirements:

NUMBER-OF-CYBERBULLYING-INCIDENTS (E1728) indicates the number of reported incidents of cyberbullying at each campus.

Cyberbullying means bullying that is done through the use of any electronic communication device, including through the use of a cellular or other type of telephone, a computer, a camera, electronic mail, instant messaging, text messaging, a social media application, an Internet website, or any other Internet-based communication tool.

Cyberbullying incidents can occur

1. On or be delivered to school property or to the site of a school-sponsored or school-related activity on or off school property,
2. On a publicly or privately owned school bus or vehicle being used for transportation of students to or from school or a school-sponsored or school-related activity, and
3. Off school property or outside of a school-sponsored or school-related activity if the cyberbullying interferes with a student's educational opportunities or substantially disrupts the orderly operation of a classroom, school, or school-sponsored or school-related activity.

The NUMBER-OF-CYBERBULLYING-INCIDENTS (E1728) will be equal to or less than the NUMBER-OF-BULLYING-INCIDENTS (E1727).
