Clint ISD to Provide FREE Meals to ALL Enrolled Students via Pickup/Delivery Service During the 2020-2021 School Year

Starting Tuesday August 11, 2020, we will be delivering school meals to additional areas within the community. This will allow students and parents to stay at home with less instructional interruptions. Meals will still be available for pick up at each campus and for onsite bus route deliveries. Bus route schedules are posted on our main website.

Meal Pick Up at Clint ISD Schools

The weekday service will be available from **11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. for pick up** at all elementary, middle, and high schools in the district. Service will be available via a drive-through or walk-up process. The meal pick-up will include lunch for the current day and a cold breakfast to be consumed the following morning.

Meals will be provided for all Clint ISD enrolled students free of charge. Only one family member, preferably an adult, is required to pick up meals at schools for all children with the following documentation/information: students full name, student ID, student address and campus name.

Lunches are intended to be eaten immediately or should be stored in the refrigerator within 1 hour. Cold foods (milk & cheese & yogurt) should be kept cold, under 41 degrees. Hot foods are intended to be eaten immediately after being served and consumed hot. If item becomes cold, please reheat to hot (165F). Discard any leftovers stored in refrigeration after 3 days.



Meal Delivery by Clint ISD Transportation

Clint ISD school buses will be stopping at the locations listed and will have meals available for pick up. Each day the meal will include lunch for the current day and a cold breakfast to be stored and eaten on the following day. Families will need to refrigerate cold breakfast items immediately after pick up to ensure the safety of the food for the next morning.



Meals will be provided for all Clint ISD enrolled students free of charge. Only one family member, preferably an adult, is required to pick up meals at schools for all children with the following documentation/information: students full name, student ID, student address and campus name.

All times/routes are subject to change based on participation. Changes or updates will be posted on the District's web page.
