WEEKLY Attendance Incentive: If your child is present each day and in class before the tardy bell rings at 7:25 A.M., and they stay for the entire day (**Dr.'s note required to excuse early pull out**), they are eligible for "**Free Dress Day**" on **Monday** of the following week. *Teachers will notify students on Friday whether or not they qualify for free dress.* * There are no carryovers if your child is absent on Monday.

Here are some "Free Dress Day" guidelines:



- No tank top / spaghetti straps
- No flip flops
- No torn jeans / pants / shorts
- Dresses, skirts, and shorts cannot be more than 3 inches above the knee.
- All words & graphics on clothing must be appropriate.

Additional Classroom Incentives: Teachers will have additional incentives for their classrooms when they spell out "PERFECT ATTENDANCE". Incentives will be determined & provided by teachers and may include items such as: Goodie treat, Sit by friend, Lunch with Teacher, Pencils/Stickers, Go Noodle Time, 10 Minutes Free Time, etc.

MONTHLY Incentives: The classroom with the most perfect attendance days in the month, will earn a special treat. *Examples may include: popcorn, cookie, Popsicle, etc.* Classes will compete by grade level. There will be one winning class per grade level. In case of a tie, competition will continue into the next month until a winner is identified.

QUARTERLY Incentives: Every 9 weeks, students with **perfect attendance (no absences)** will receive a certificate and enjoy a Domino's Pizza lunch. In addition, one class will win a Peter Piper Pizza Party in their classroom. Students will also be recognized at our 9 Week Assemblies.
