## **I-LEARN@HOME Addendum to the Student Code of Conduct 2020-2021**

Clint ISD welcomes our students back for the 2020-2021 school year. During this pandemic, students may be taught through a remote learning environment which we have given the name, I-LEARN@HOME. Students are expected to adhere to the rules outlined in the Student Code of Conduct as well as these additional rules for the 2020-2021 school year. Students may also sign an **I-LEARN@HOME Agreement** which will be provided by the campuses.

### **General Expectations for the I-LEARN@HOME Learning Process**

- ✓ All students must have the necessary technology to effectively and regularly communicate, receive instruction, interact with class, and comply with work requirements.
- ✓ Clint ISD will continue to monitor daily attendance through student log in to remote learning. In addition, compliance with all required assignments and assessments will be used to monitor student attendance. Students are subject to the 90% rule during remote learning.
- ✓ Students must comply with all work requirements in a timely manner (meeting deadlines) and reach out to the teacher when student is experiencing difficulty with the material or with meeting the assignment deadline.

### **General Expectations during Live Conferencing Sessions**

Video conferencing and live group sessions are essential components of the learning process and help improve the connectedness of remote team members. As with the use of social media, students are required to adhere to school policies pertaining to these areas in our Student Code of Conduct, and to observe the following regarding the Remote Learning environment:

- ✓ Students must be punctual to the live conferencing sessions scheduled by the teacher.
- ✓ Teachers will be monitoring and recording student attendance through live conferencing sessions.
- ✓ Ensure your technology works properly and frame the camera correctly.
- ✓ Good online manners are vital to a productive and supportive online learning environment. Students are expected to behave in the live session as expected in the regular in-person class. **Live sessions may be recorded.** The following Netiquette guidelines apply to all online communications:
  - Students may follow Clint ISD dress code as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.
    - Students at the elementary and middle school levels are not expected to wear uniforms, but should be appropriately dressed. Students at that level should dress as they would on a Free Dress Day.
    - School spirit shirts are encouraged.

- Students should be clothed at all times – male students may not be on camera shirtless.
- Students will not be allowed to wear pajamas, clothing with inappropriate language/graphics, or be on camera in their underclothes.
- Be mindful of inappropriate surroundings or potential interruptions of the session.
- Sessions are intended for the learners in the particular class and should not include individuals who are not part of the regular group.
- Be polite, respectful and tolerant of views expressed by others.
- Students are not to exchange any private information with each other.
- Mute your microphone when others are talking.
- Keep chat book or messaging usage appropriate.
- Do not purposely distract others.
- Cyberbullying will not be tolerated.

### **General Expectations for Student Learning**

The goal of I-LEARN@HOME is to engage students in meaningful, online, teacher-guided instruction. Students will communicate directly with their teachers and classmates through the I-LEARN@HOME experience. The following are expectations of parents and students.

#### **Parents will be expected to:**

- Assure that our child/children readily have working, district provided Chromebooks, as well as internet access to participate in I-LEARN@HOME instruction.
- Know our child's/children's schedule for each school day.
- Ensure that our child/children are actively engaged in I-LEARN@HOME during your home campus' designated school day hours.
- Make sure that all assignments given to our child/children are completed on time.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions related to our child/children's education.
- Stay informed about our child/children's education and communicate with the teachers, counselors, administration or appropriate school personnel.

#### **Students will be expected to:**

- Login on time to all classes scheduled.
- Actively participate in all class activities, readings, assignments, discussions and projects.
- Do all assigned homework every day and ask for help when needed.
- Attend I-LEARN@HOME classes every day in order to maintain excellent attendance and maximize learning. Classes are subject to the 90% rule.
- Complete assignments honestly and not turn in work that was intentionally completed by someone else. No plagiarism.
- Be respectful with all participants and during all class activities both verbally and in writing.
- Dress appropriately as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct and the Addendum above.
- Share with our parents/guardians notices and information received from our home campus in a timely manner.
