

**CLINT HIGH SCHOOL 2023-2024 HOMECOMING PARADE PARTICIPATION RULES & REGISTRATION FORM**

1. All participants must submit a completed application form by Friday, September 8, 2023 at 4:30 pm to the front office at Clint High School and leave for Anissa Bravo.
2. All participants must pay a **\$20 registration** fee and turned in with the application by Friday, September 8, 2023 at 4:30 pm. You will be issued a receipt at the time of payment. Cash or Check made out to Clint High School. There are NO REFUNDS.
3. All participants must be lined up by 4:45 pm at Clint Junior High School, 12625 Alameda Ave, Clint, Texas 79836. Please report to the parking lot behind the tennis courts. Everyone will line up behind the Clint Fire Department. You will be given a section number for your line-up order.
4. All vehicles in the parade **must be decorated** and in good working order and must comply with the Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of Texas. A copy of the operator's driver's license and insurance policy must be submitted along with this application.
5. **No STUDENTS will be allowed to drive and there MUST be an adult supervisor for each float.** Any float without adult supervision will not be allowed in the parade regardless of payment, license, or insurance.
6. Participants must supply their own music and/or sound equipment. Clint High School assumes no responsibility for the music or sound systems. Music must be edited for language and in good taste with no foul or degrading language as this is a family and community event.
7. Participants' attire must be in good taste. Participant's may give out candy or trinkets safely to the public. Please keep safety as your priority.
8. No political campaigning or distribution of political propaganda will be allowed during the parade.
9. Participants may not engage in any activity that may represent a safety hazard to the participants or spectators.
10. Participants who will have live animals (such as horses) as part of their float, will be responsible for leaving CJHS parking lot and the parade route clean and in the same condition as it was prior to the start of the parade. An adult who is responsible for clean-up will be required to check-in the animals and present appropriate gear for any on-site clean-up needs. If there is no adult present who is will be assuming that role, the float will not be allowed to participate in the parade regardless of registration fees having been paid.
11. Please do not allow parents of participants, participants, or other affiliated community members of your float to park their cars in the parking lot directly behind CJHS where floats line-up. This creates an incredible amount of congestion for floats and causes confusion when the parade begins. Please have all participants meet at an alternative spot that is not the parking lot and when all members are present, then please proceed as a group to the parking lot. Only floats and participating vehicles should be in the parking lot between 4:20 PM and 5:30 PM.
12. No floats, animals, or other parade vehicles may remain on Clint High School Premises after the parade has ended.
13. Violation of these rules will constitute grounds for removal from the parade and disciplinary action may be taken.

**Homecoming Parade: Wednesday, September 13, 2023 from 5:30 – 6:30 pm**

The parade will start in the parking lot of Clint Junior High School (12625 Alameda, Clint, Texas 79836) and head east on Pioneer Drive towards Williams Street. It will turn left on Williams and turn right onto Lawson Ave. The route will continue down Lawson Ave. and turn right on Main Street. From Main Street, it will turn left onto TX 20 Alameda Avenue and continue on Alameda in the East Bound lanes to Clint High School (13890 Alameda, Clint, Texas 79836).

Clint High School will work with the SRO's from Clint ISD and the Clint Fire Department to coordinate this event. All Emergency Services will be notified.

Clint Fire Department will lead and end the parade with Emergency Vehicles. The Sheriff Deputies, in conjunction with all additional support, will provide moving road closures on TX 20 (Alameda). They will also stop the parade if too much traffic congestion occurs and allow traffic through if necessary. Road Closures will include:

- Alameda and Main
- Alameda and FM1110
- Alameda and Herring Road
- Alameda west bound traffic will be redirected on Denton Road
