What is PBIS?

PBIS is:

- a positive behavior management process to create safer and more effective schools.
- a system of clear schoolwide expectations with consequences and incentives.
- intervention when you need help.
- recognition and celebration for your successes



What does PBIS do for you?

- Students are recognized and praised for positive behaviors.
(snacks, purchase IDs, school supplies, materials, etc.)

- Students receive interventions to help them refocus their unsuccessful behaviors.

(teacher-student conference, parent contact, reflections, lunch bunch, Falcon Friday, parent conference, administrative referral.)



How Does PBIS Work?



- All students follow the same set of rules and expectations throughout all areas in the building.
- When students follow the rules and expectations, they are recognized.
- When students do not follow the rules, there are planned consequences to help them get back on track.



PBIS (Positive Behavior)

- Earn Points for showing up to school, having your ID, or being respectful
- Spend your points at the Falcon Nest (Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 3:45-4:15)
